Highlights of 2014

- Dominican Republic:** Our care centers at Constanza and Palo Blanco have been converted into private Christian schools. We will now be able to spend more quality time with our children and increase their achievements in school even further. And we have increased our reach this year by approximately 100 children, to a total of 1,700 kids at our 10 ministry sites.
- Guatemala:** The Oasis has been expanded to include child-moms and pregnant children with five girls (ages 12-14) who were pregnant as a result of abuse. It is a blessing and miracle to watch our team work with these young girls to help them heal and learn to love their babies.
- Haiti:** A total of 12 Service Teams traveled to Haiti in 2014. Construction continues on our 5th Home at our Children's Village and our kids are moving into their new permanent homes as they are finished. Additionally, building is currently underway on our new school.
- Kenya:** Fourteen of the young people we rescued out of horrific home situations have now completed university or higher education programs. Another 16 are studying this year and several have returned to take staff positions with Kids Alive. Thank God for transformed lives!
- Lebanon:** While Lebanon has received over 1.1 million refugees from the Syrian war, Kids Alive is doing its part by launching a new literacy program, called the Oasis, for 60 Syrian refugee children. Our prayer is that the lives of these children and their parents will be transformed as they experience the love of Christ through the Oasis.
- Romania:** Service teams from the USA, Hong Kong and Taiwan came to bless our children along with our dentist friend from Ireland (who cares for our kids' dental needs), a math teacher from the UK and friends from the US who sponsor the House of Hope and serve on our Board. It was truly love and care from all over the world!
- Papua New Guinea:** Because we train teachers, send building materials and teaching curriculum up river to the remotest areas, more than 800 children are now in Kids Alive schools, learning essential skills and hearing the Good News of Jesus Christ.
- Peru:** Construction has been completed on two Children's Homes in Pucallpa and we've appointed a Peruvian director. Before we open our Homes, we need to fill a few more staff positions. We still need to find Child Sponsors for each girl and boy moving into their new Home!
- South Sudan:** The completion of our first new Children's Home at Wau is a huge answer to prayer. We are very grateful for a larger plot of land, bigger rooms so boys can play, our own security wall and a place to plant some vegetables. To these needy children, this is the "Promised Land!"
- Zambia:** We celebrate the opening of our first Children's Home at the Chikondi Children's Village in Lusaka. Two more children have also been rescued from the clutches of witchcraft and have found new life in Jesus.





Time, Talents and Treasure

A greater vision...a targeted focus...a deeper commitment, those are the building blocks of a healthy church. And that's exactly what Pastor Bill Bump has seen happen over the past few years as Lawrence (Kansas) Free Methodist Church has partnered with Kids Alive. "It's so natural — uniting the church together behind a singular great cause like Kids Alive Haiti. Getting people involved on so many different levels. It's a breath of new life."

All this good started with a Service Team in 2005. To date, this Kansas church has sent 14 teams to Haiti and other countries. Another two teams are scheduled for Haiti in 2015. In their own community this church has also sponsored several events including a 4-mile run called "4 For Others" and a pancake breakfast — events in one week that raised nearly \$3,000 for Kids Alive Haiti. Their Vacation Bible School raised another \$2,500 to fund the plumbing in one new Children's Home. And there is a church-wide effort to raise funds to complete another Children's Home. Time, talents and treasure — all invested to accomplish the work of the church.

90 Teams/1,150 People!

This year alone, 90 volunteer Service Teams consisting of over 1,150 people traveled to our ministry sites around the world to serve. Whether in construction, education, medical care or the many other skills they shared, these men, women and youth also shared the Good News of God's love to children who need to know someone cares. Unique outreaches this year have included soccer camps for kids, teaching sewing skills, providing missionary retreats and training lawyers and organizations to work with legal systems to protect children.

600+ Co-laborers!


